

### **The Gospels (The Manifestation of the Word)**

1. **Matthew:** The genealogy and administration of Christ the King are set forth, proving Him to be the true Messiah who fulfills the Law and Prophets.
2. **Mark:** A portrayal of the Suffering Servant of Jehovah, who came not to be ministered unto, but to labor with urgency and give His life a ransom for many.
3. **Luke:** The Son of Man is revealed in His tender mercies, seeking out the lost to bring salvation to the Gentiles.
4. **John:** A profound declaration of the Divinity of Christ, the Eternal Word, who alone is the Light of the World and the source of everlasting life.

### **History (The Acts of the Spirit)**

5. **Acts:** The working of the Holy Ghost is displayed in the planting of the Church, empowering earthen vessels to proclaim the Gospel from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth.

### **The Pauline Epistles (Doctrine and Duty)**

6. **Romans:** The great cathedral of our theology, expounding the sinfulness of man and his justification solely by the imputed righteousness of Christ through faith.
7. **1 Corinthians:** A sharp reproof to a carnal church, calling them away from schisms and disorder to the purity and charity that befits the Body of Christ.
8. **2 Corinthians:** The Apostle defends his ministry, showing that the power of God is most gloriously displayed in the weakness and afflictions of His servants.
9. **Galatians:** A passionate defense of Christian liberty, warning the flock against the yoke of grace through works and asserting that the just shall live by faith alone.
10. **Ephesians:** A treatise on the salvation of the saints and their mystic union with Christ, urging them to walk worthy of so high a calling.
11. **Philippians:** An exhortation to holy rejoicing and contentment in the midst of trials, counting all worldly gain as dung for the surpassing worth of knowing Christ.
12. **Colossians:** The preeminence of Christ is asserted against vain philosophies, declaring that in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.
13. **1 Thessalonians:** A comfort to the young believers regarding those who sleep in Jesus, pointing their hope toward the blessed return of the Lord.
14. **2 Thessalonians:** A warning against idleness and deception, clarifying the events that must precede the coming of the Day of the Lord.
15. **1 Timothy:** A charge to a young pastor regarding the order of the house of God, that sound doctrine and godliness might be preserved.
16. **2 Timothy:** The dying charge of the Apostle, urging his son in the faith to endure hardship and preach the Word in season and out of season.
17. **Titus:** Instruction on the establishing of elders and the necessity of maintaining good works, that the doctrine of God our Savior may be adorned.
18. **Philemon:** A pleading for Christian charity, that a runaway slave be received back not as a bondsman, but as a beloved brother in the Lord.

### **The General Epistles (Exhortations to the Pilgrims)**

19. **Hebrews:** A demonstration that the shadows and types of the Old Covenant have given way to the substance of Christ, our Great High Priest and final Sacrifice.
20. **James:** A piercing admonition that genuine faith must be evidenced by works, for a profession of religion without a bridled tongue and charity is dead.
21. **1 Peter:** A comfort to the elect exiles, encouraging them to stand firm in the true grace of God and to suffer patiently for righteousness' sake.
22. **2 Peter:** A warning against the damnable heresies of false teachers and a reminder that the Lord's delay is but His patience leading men to repentance.
23. **1 John:** A test of true assurance, distinguishing the children of light from the children of the devil by their love for the brethren and obedience to the truth.
24. **2 John:** A brief warning to the elect lady to walk in truth and to refuse hospitality to those who bring not the doctrine of Christ.
25. **3 John:** A commendation of Gaius for his support of the itinerant truth-bearers, standing in contrast to the prideful ambition of Diotrephes.
26. **Jude:** A trumpet blast summoning the faithful to contend earnestly for the faith once delivered against the ungodly men creeping in unawares.

### **Prophecy (The Final Victory)**

27. **Revelation:** A majestic vision of the Throne of God, the judgment of the wicked, and the marriage supper of the Lamb, wherein Christ is crowned Lord of All.
