

### The Pentateuch: The Books of the Law

### The Historical Books: The Providence of the King

- **Joshua:** He is the **Lord of Hosts**, the Captain of our Salvation, who remains true to every jot and tittle of His promise.
- **Judges:** We behold His **Long-suffering Patience**, for though His people go a-whoring after idols, His bowels of mercy yet yearn for them.
- **Ruth:** A sweet testimony of His **Microscopic Providence**, showing that even in the lives of the lowly, the Almighty is weaving a tapestry of redemption.
- **1 & 2 Samuel:** He is the **Searcher of Hearts**, who rejects the proud stature of Saul but exalts the humble shepherd, establishing an Eternal Throne.
- **1 & 2 Kings & Chronicles:** The **Governor of Nations**, who pulls down tyrants and weighs kings in the balance of His righteous Law.
- **Ezra & Nehemiah:** The **Restorer of the Remnant**, who stirs the spirits of men to rebuild the waste places for His Name's sake.
- **Esther:** He is the **Hidden Arranger**, whose hand is most active when His face is most veiled, protecting His Church from the gallows of the enemy.

### The Poetic Books: The Wisdom of the High God

- **Job:** He is the **Unfathomable Supreme**, before whom every mouth must be stopped. He giveth and He taketh away; blessed be His Name.
- **Psalms:** The **Intimate Comforter** and the Worthy Object of all adoration—a Fortress for the saint and a Terror to the wicked.

- **Ecclesiastes:** The **Only Portion** of the soul; for all beneath the sun is but vanity and vexation of spirit if God be not the center.
- **Song of Solomon:** A shadow of the **Celestial Bridegroom**, whose love for His Church is stronger than death and more jealous than the grave.

### The Prophets: The Voice of the Holy One

- **Isaiah:** He is the **Thrice-Holy Lord**, high and lifted up, yet promising a Lowly Servant to bear the iniquities of us all.

- **Ezekiel:** The **God of Glory**, who departs from the defiled temple but promises a new heart of flesh to replace the heart of stone.
- **Daniel:** The **Ancient of Days**, whose Kingdom is an everlasting Kingdom, and before whom the beasts of the earth are as nothing.
- **The Minor Prophets:** From Hosea's **Unyielding Affection** to Malachi's **Unchanging Purity**, they declare that the Lord, He is God; He changes not, therefore the sons of Jacob are not consumed.
